

ORDINANCE NO. 09-05

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 09-03 REGULATING THE KEEPING AND CONTROL OF COMPANION/DOMESTIC ANIMALS IN THE CITY OF GREENWOOD, ARKANSAS, DECLARING AN EMERGENCY AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

WHEREAS, The City Council of the City of Greenwood has determined there is a need to add additional locations for residents within the city limits to register their animals; and

WHEREAS, the two veterinary clinics, Greenwood Veterinary Clinic and South County Animal Hospital, have agreed to accept the responsibility of registering the animals in addition to registration at City Hall,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREENWOOD, ARKANSAS:

Section 1: An amendment to the first sentence in Section 1 of Ordinance 09-03 will read as follows: Every domestic animal within the city limits will be required to be registered at any of the three locations; Greenwood Veterinary Clinic, South County Animal Hospital or at the City Hall. If registration is provided by one of the veterinary clinics, they will retain \$1.00 of each registration fee for administrative cost.

Section 2: This Ordinance being necessary for the preservation of public peace, health and welfare, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication.
